Ordinance No. 16 of the Rector of Poznan University of Technology of 17 March 2020 (RO/III/16/2020)

on limiting the work of the University due to the state of epidemic threat in Poland

Pursuant to Article 23 section 1 of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 85) and article 207 § 2 of the Labour Code, in connection with the Act of 2 March 2020 on special solutions related to preventing, counteracting and combating COVID-19, other infectious diseases and emergencies caused by them (Journal of Laws, item 374) and the ordinance of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 16 March 2020 amending the ordinance concerning the temporary limitation of the functioning of some entities of the higher education and science system in relation to preventing, counteracting and combating COVID-19 (Journal of Laws of Laws, item 455), it is ordered as follows:

§'

From 17 March 2020, restricted access to University buildings for persons who are not PUT employees or Ph.D. students participating in scientific research shall be introduced.

§2

In the period from 18 March to 25 March 25 2020, the University employees (both academic and non-academic staff) shall not be required to work at the University, except for cases when it is necessary to ensure the continuity of the University's operation.

§3

- 1. Vice-Rectors, Deans and the Chief Financial Officer shall be authorized and obliged to organize the work of supervised organizational units in order to ensure the continuity of the University's operation.
- 2. The provisions of Ordinance No. 14 of the Rector of Poznan University of Technology of 11 March 11 2020, including the possibility to impose on an employee the duty of performing remote work, shall remain in force.

This Ordinance shall enter into force on the day of signature.
